Coaching seminar (December 16-17, 2010): Evangelical School of Theology, in cooperation with the PROC Foundation, will offer coaching training for Christian leaders, both clergy and laity and anyone planning to use coaching in a church, Christian organization, and team building, and others who are interested in personal and professional development. School of Leaders: A one-year practical course for pastors, church leaders, missionaries and people involved with Christian organizations. The purpose is to support and help these leaders grow in their ministries. mainly in three areas: Evangelism, Discipleship and Pastoral Care. The aim is to establish an ecumenical community of encouragement, inspiration and leadership development for evangelical church leaders throughout Poland.

Open Theological Academy: As a result of building relationships with pastors we now have several contacts with churches where our lecturers are invited to teach and preach at the church campus on a regular basis.

School of Christian Apologetics: This is a new program launched this year in order to help evangelical Christians broaden their knowledge in the area of apologetics, which is often necessary in their various evangelism and disciple ministries.

Week of Prayer for Unity of Christians (January 2011): EST is working with representatives of churches in Wroclaw to plan this important week. The participants will meet for prayer and words of encouragement at the EST campus and in different churches throughout Wroclaw.
